Amy Hall, Program Director, waived the RFP requirement for questions to be submitted in advance in writing. Questions were entertained at the conference today.

Question: Please expand on Core measures

Answer: No extra data need be entered specifically aimed at meeting the Core Performance measures as WV has a waiver in place to only have to report on Common Measures. Information needed for reporting Core Performance measures will be drawn from data already entered in the MACC.

Question: Page 10, #3 under “past performance” please expand on “similar size and scope”.

Answer: Fill out one form for each youth related program grant your agency may have received in the past five years. Do not fill out one for each year operating under a grant from the same awarding agency for the same program.

Question: Expand on “size”.

Answer: Comparable to the current grant “size” (i.e. funding amount).

Question: Page 9 under “work plan”. What is “staff to youth ratio”?

Answer: Ex.: If there are 130 youth and 3 staff, the math would be 130 divided by 3 equaling a staff to youth ratio of 43.

Question: Do ARRA funds and BIKISI need to be mentioned?

Answer: No, not in relation to this RFP. Those programs will be separate and only be addressed as the occasion demands in the upcoming program year.

Question: Do transitional plans need to be mentioned if minor?

Answer: No. If you plan changes in how you would operate the PY 10 program, and those changes mean the program will operate significantly different than the current program operations, then explain how the transition will be made for participants to seamlessly incorporate the changes.

Question: Page 5 under “core measures”, first paragraph, fourth line down, Core Performance Measures are mentioned. Was this an oversight since we no longer have to do extra reporting to meet them? Please explain.

Answer: Core Performance Measures were only mentioned in the RFP to explain why they were eliminated from consideration in this RFP as compared to the previous RFP issued in 07.
